* HELP ANIMALS STAY HYDRATED



The Whistling School Boy by Ruskin Bond



"Young Explorers"

Craft: Make a keyboard model using cardboard and buttons.

Materials Needed:

- Old cardboard sheet
- Buttons or small beads/bottle caps
- Glue
- Black marker or sketch pen
- Scissors (under adult supervision)
- Optional: paint, colored paper, labels

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a rectangle from the cardboard to make the keyboard base (approx. 25 cm x 10 cm).
- 2. Arrange buttons or caps in rows, just like a real keyboard (3–4 rows).
- 3. Glue each button in place.
- 4. Use a marker to write letters or numbers on the buttons. You can also cut small squares of paper and write on them.
- 5. Label special keys like:
 - a. Spacebar (use a long strip of paper or cardboard)
 - b. Enter
 - c. Shift
 - d. Delete

Decorating Ideas:

- Paint or color the cardboard base.
- Add a paper title: "My Handmade Keyboard"
- Use glitter or washi tape to make borders fun and colorful.
